WIRELESS REVERSING CAMERA

Reversing cameras are becoming increasingly popular optional extras, especially on longer 'vans, but retro-fitting by a workshop can be expensive. Also, with the amount of wiring involved, it's normally to tricky to do yourself. But this wireless reversing camera, from CCD, makes DIY fitting much easier. The camera uses a transmitter to broadcast the image to a seven-inch TFT monitor in the cab, with no wiring to thread between the two.
